Our Measures


The following will be implemented as standard at our forthcoming events:


 Temperature checks for attendees and staff on arrival


 Any areas where queuing may occur will be monitored with correct spacing indicators

 Gloves and masks will be distributed for you to use as you see fit

 Stages will be sanitised between panels and talks, including seating and microphones

 Hand sanitiser will be widely available throughout all spaces at all times

 Buffet style food will not be available, and instead you will have the option of plated or pre-packaged meals

 Reorganised seating will be implemented to give everyone the recommended amount of distance from one another
